GYNAE CAMP FOR WOMEN



On the 7th of March, a Gynae camp was organized for the women in the area. A full physical examination, blood test, BP check and pap smear of all the patients were done. Full medical history of each patient was also recorded. A total number 70 of ladies were screened out of which 15 were referred for further tests and are

currently undergoing treatment at AIIMS.

The camp was sponsored by Mrs Sushma Prakash and Mr Sood.



CARDIAC CAMP



On the 1st of March a Cardiac camp was held in collaboration with the Metro Heart Institute. A team of Doctors, nurses and technicians from the



hospital, along with the Savera medical team, screened a total of 106 patients. Out of these patients, 25 were detected with ECG abnormality, 30 with high BP and 17 were found to be highly diabetic.

LIQUID EMBROIDERY



From 4th to 10th March we had a skill upgradation workshop for Ladies who are stitching and embroidering. A five day liquid embroidery training for ladies was organised by Pidilite, after which the girls had an exhibition of the items they made. All participants were then awarded certificates from Pidilite.
